of their creator

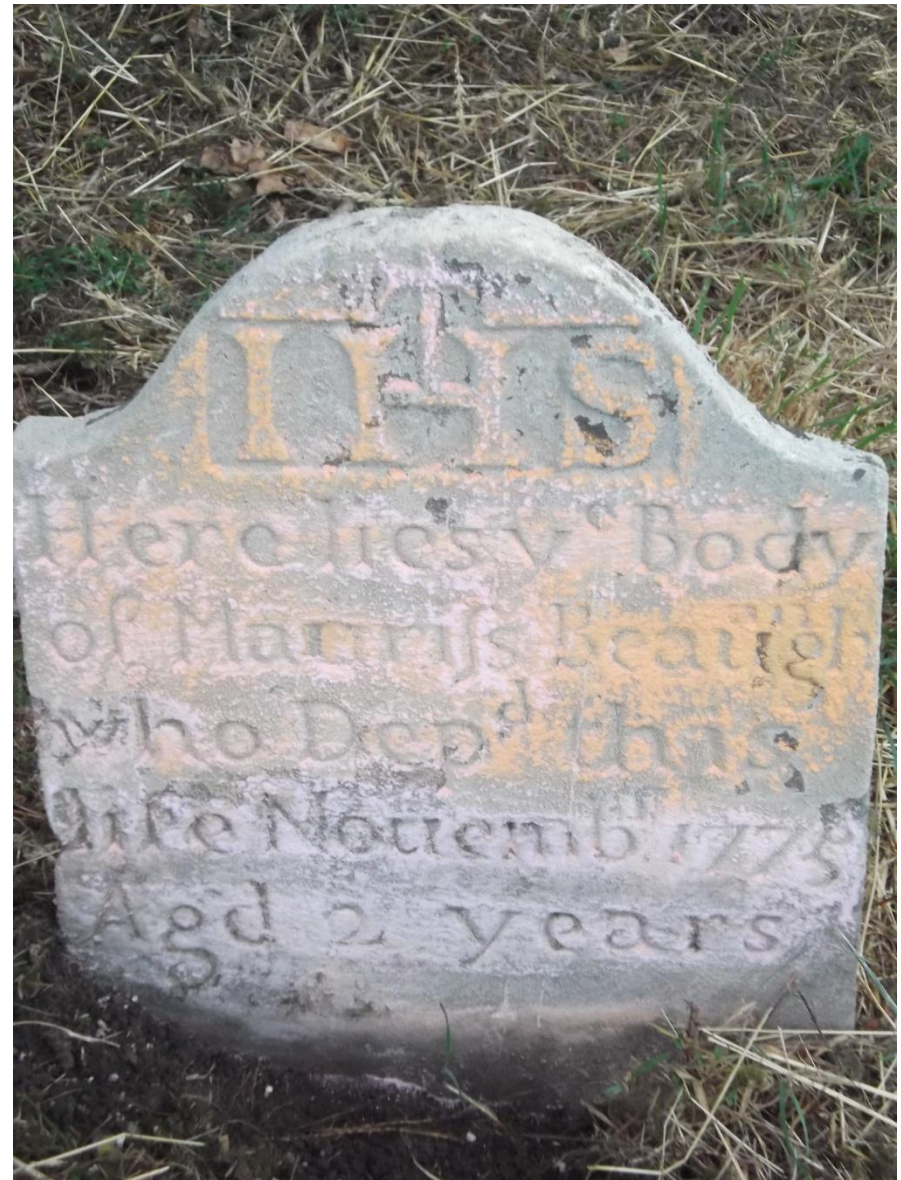
This tomb was erected by their mourning
